Warm-up - Sand, grass area and 200' indoor warmup arena

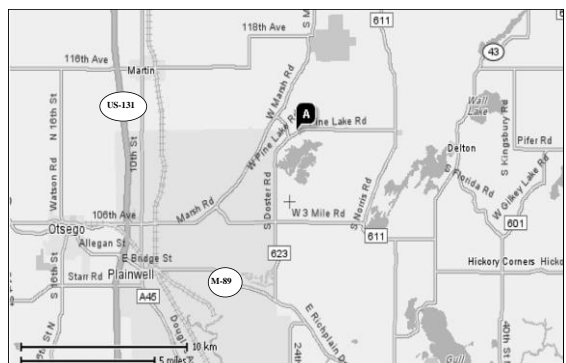
Dogs- No Dogs, Please.

Directions from Plainwell- Go 6 miles East on M-89 from Plainwell. Turn North on Doster Rd for 6 miles.

Or in Plainwell go north on Main st, East on Marsh Rd 7 miles , right on Graham, Left on Pine Lake Rd.

Directions from Richland- From the corner of M-89 & M-43 , go West 6 miles on M-89. Turn North on Doster Rd for 6 miles.

Directions from Delton- From M-43, go West on Delton Rd 3 miles, turn right on Norris Rd for 1 mile, turn left (West) on Pine Lake Rd for 3 miles.
