Entry Information

Entries accepted under rules in the Glass-Ed and Michiana Dressage Club Omnibus. Entries due by closing date; late entries \$5 per class; no entries within 72 hours of competition. Entries may be mailed or emailed. Test of Choice: Riders may ride any test Intro–FEI and more than one test but not the same test twice; test must be listed on entry form. Scores from this show count toward year-end awards for Transitions Equestrian Center, Glass-Ed, and Michiana Dressage Club.

Refunds / Scratches

Refund requests must be submitted before closing date. After closing date refunds require signed Vet Health Certificate received 2 days before show; approved refunds less \$10 office fee. Scratches must be submitted 24 hours prior by email or text Melissa (269) 923-9088; day-of scratches report to entry table. No refunds for scratches.

Stabling

Limited stalls; first come, first served. \$35 day stall; \$45 night before + show day; \$80 weekend. Includes 2 wheelbarrows shavings; additional \$15/load. No stall refunds after closing date. Stall payment does not guarantee availability; if unavailable payment will be refunded. Check-in after 5 PM day before show; stalls must be stripped by 3 PM show day unless approved. Transitions will strip stalls \$15 fee. Bring feed/water buckets. Stalled horses require Flu/Rhino and Strangles vaccines. Text arrival time (269) 923-9088.

Vaccinations

Submit negative Coggins and Flu/Rhino vaccinations with entry. Horses stalling must also show Strangles vaccination.

Dress / Schooling

Schooling available after 5 PM day before competition; arenas cleared 30 minutes before competition for dragging.
Schooling areas: indoor arena, outdoor arena, round pen.
ASTM/SEI helmets required when mounted. Traditional dressage or western attire; 2026 USEF-approved bits.
Gaited horses welcome.

Warm-Up Etiquette

Pass left shoulder to left shoulder in warm-up areas.

Arena / Weather Plan

Competition in outdoor arena weather permitting; if footing is unsafe or too wet, competition moves to indoor arena.

Food

Food and beverages available at concession area.

Checkout

Return competition numbers after final class; clean manure and hay around trailers. Stalls must be completely stripped; Transitions will strip stalls \$15 fee.

Dogs / Stallions

No dogs allowed on property. Stallions permitted only with Open riders age 18+; management may scratch stallion if unsafe with no refund.

Trailer Parking / Camping

Park trailers in designated areas. Camping \$20 no hookup / \$30 electric hookup; limited spaces; bring extension cords.

Awards / High Percentage

Ribbons 1st–6th. Minimum 4 riders per division for High Percentage Championship. Riders must compete in two tests in same division; championship calculated by average of two highest scores per horse/rider.

Scores count toward Transitions Equestrian Center Year-End Awards, Glass-Ed Year-End Awards, and Michiana Dressage Club Region 2 Year-End Awards.

Show Management

Management reserves the right to combine, divide, cancel, or modify classes as necessary.

Liability

Liability: I understand horses and horseback riding can be dangerous. I enter the competition at my own risk and will not hold Transitions LLC, Transitions Staff, or Volunteers responsible for any injures that my horse, myself, show guest or my property.
